

PART 3: RESPONSIBILITY FOR FUNCTIONS

This part of the Constitution indicates who is responsible for decision making in respect of the Council's functions.

PART 3 - SECTION 1 – NON EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONS

1. The Local Authorities (Functions and Responsibilities) (England) Regulations 2000 provide that the following Functions may not be exercised by the Executive.
2. Alongside each Function there is specified the Committee or Officer (in some cases both) to whom the Function has been delegated. Full details of the delegations are set out in Part 3 Sections 3 and 5
