Good Morning

I am emailing on behalf of my parents who reside on Wigan Road, near the Royal. After a number of months of discussions and phone calls re the traffic coming through the backs of the houses to the Pooches Playhouse and creating potholes and unnecessary stress to residents, the council have installed 2 beautiful planters to prevent such traffic coming down the backs.

This has given residents, including my parents, piece of mind that they can walk out if their gates without the fear of being run over as the cars do on occasion drive at speed down to the Pooches Playhouse.

The [REDACTED] of Pooches Playhouse has taken to Facebook and, in my opinion, overdramatised the situation

The planters are a temporary measure to monitor the traffic situation and as part of an open consultation (see attached letter). When customers are dropping their dogs off, they can still drive up by the pub, drop off and using the turning circle, drive back out, without the need of driving down the back of Wigan Road.

I have attached some photos for your consideration, as, the official entrance to Pooches Play House is off Bag Lane and onto Coal Pit Lane, where you can clearly see that there is a road for customers to drive down as well as parking and the entrance to the unit, so, I am somewhat confused as to why having the planters installed is an issue?

The attached leaflet also states where the entrance is but customers feel that driving up the alley way near the pub is more convenient, well, as far as I can see, this hasn't changed?

The Window Men also use the Coal Pit Lane entrance for deliveries and pickups. They have also welcomed the Planters and the blocking of the Backs is not an issue for them.

The [redacted] has been extremely rude on the Facebook page as well as dilutional in some of her comments as the customers have no need to drive all the way down the backs and stating that it is 'dangerous to reverse on a main road', it certainly is, but, I am struggling to understand why you would have to do this?

There are a no of residents who have suffered severe anxiety and stress over this situation and some no longer come out of their houses during the day. The dogs bark from when it opens til it shuts and my parents have had enough.

The simple solution is to retain the gorgeous planters, ask the customers of the Playhouse to use the official entrance and parking via Coal Pit Lane and let the residents feel safe in their homes.

I would also ask if the 'no through sign' is relocated to the top end of the backs as it is next to the Planters and needs to be at the top to prevent people from driving down who may not be aware of the situation.

I would appreciate your time on this matter, review the attached documentation as well as the facts around where the entrance to the Pooches Playhouse should be and ask that the [redacted] stops posting false and inaccurate information on her post as well as being rude to residents as the planters are not affecting their business at all.

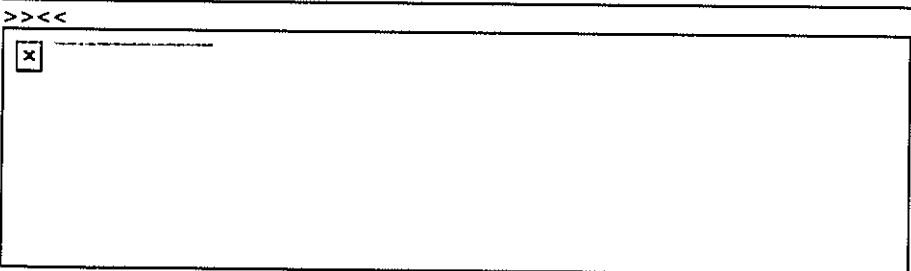

For 5 years we've been trying to get the customers of local businesses to slow down driving down ours backing to the properties with no joy. We have young children & pets with some of the residents being elderly & unstable on their feet. It is not safe for us to walk out as we've nearly been hit on a lot of occasions. Since they have been in place it is so much safer for all to use & gone back to be quiet. The places these customers are using are on Prestwich industrial etc which have their own entrance via coal pit lane or Prestwich Street (if they open the gates). We are now getting customers bullying residents on line as it is causing stress etc. Hope you understand what we are going through & that we have lived here for more than 20 years.

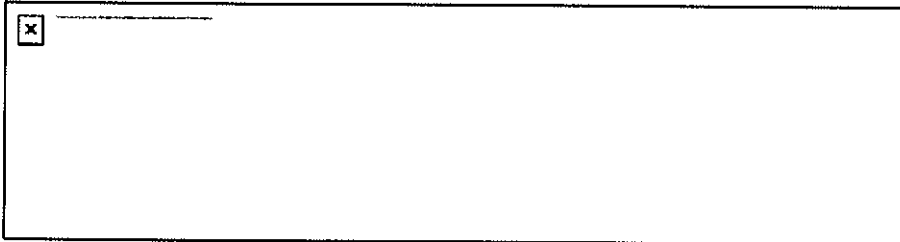

Just to follow up on my previous email, I am now getting very concerned that the planters on wigan rd Atherton may be removed, the owner and customers from pooches are now stating on social media they have been informed that the planters will be removed, they are implying the traffic is backing up on the main road, which it is not and that customers have had accidents, the owner is trying to intimidate residents by taking photos and videos of their vehicles entering and parking on their own property, I now feel we are being bullied in to giving up. This situation has been going on for 6-7 years with the owner of pooches now thinking she and her customers have a right to use the backings and abuse the residents, surely the council has a duty of care for the residents and their visitor's, a business that has 40 plus vehicles attending the property daily is not appropriately placed behind a row of houses with a backing for access, surely she should be forced into using the industrial estate for access. If the planters are to be removed I would hope measures will be implemented beforehand with the owners of the industrial estate and pooches being responsible for the cost, this whole situation has become unmanageable and I for one am become anxious and stressed with situation, I understand it is difficult but pooches customers do not live here and do not have to put up with the constant speeding issues and traffic, there is safe alternative access for her and her customers that they refuse to use. If possible please could the residents have a meeting with the council to discuss these issues.

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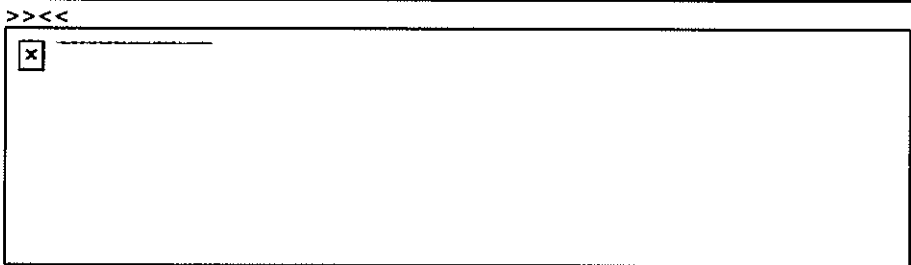

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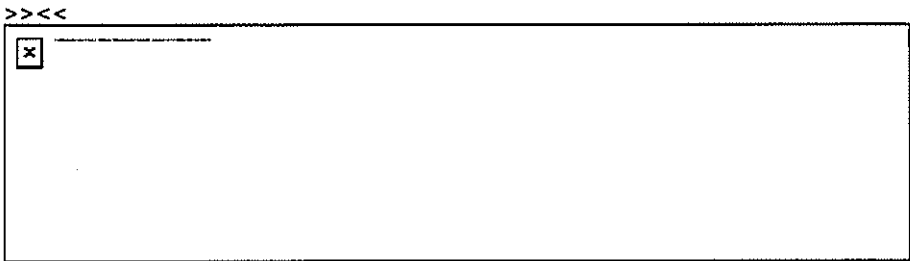

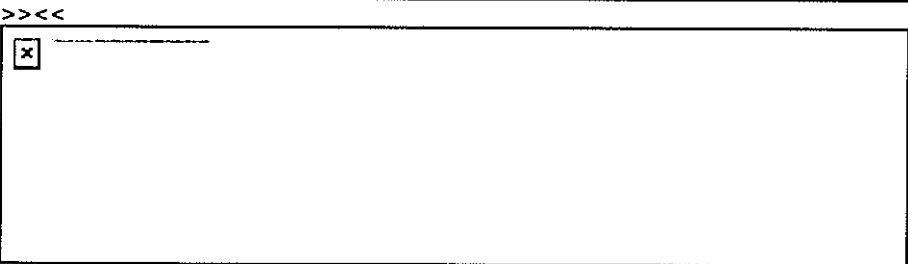

We'd like to place on record our approval of the proposed scheme to the backs of Wigan Road.

As a resident living in [REDACTED] we are sick and tired of our backs being used as a through-road for the customers using the doggy day care. Traffic starts very early in the morning and continues for most of the day with pickup and drop offs and is exceptionally busy between 7-8am and 4pm onwards. We understand they are running a business and customers have to come and go but they're access is through the industrial estate either off Prestwich Street or Coal Pit Lane (off Bag Lane)

The speed in which some of them travel down our backs is unacceptable and only a matter of time before one of our kids or pets is seriously hurt. We have had to strategically place our bins to allow us to exit our back yard with our dogs to avoid being run over, That's how bad this issue has become.

Our neighbour at [REDACTED] is very elderly and we have to put her bins out for her on Monday because it is just not safe for her to step into the backs.

I trust you will look into any objections thoroughly and check the location of any objections as we feel the only complainants will be customers from the doggy day care as its un-convenient for them.
